BCISMRM Oxford 2005: Student Stipends

BCISMRM wishes to encourage PhD students to attend the conference and present their work. To this end, a Student Stipend Fund has been allocated. Full-time PhD students who are supervised by a full member of the BC-ISMRM, and who are first author of an accepted presentation or poster will be eligible for a Stipend. The Stipends will cover the registration fee (normally £70 for PhD students) and a contribution towards travel expenses.

How to get the Student Stipend:

- Submit your abstract following the instructions on the British Chapter website, and in the covering email request a Student Stipend and note the name of your PhD supervisor. Include an estimate for your travel costs. Be reasonable, as there are limited funds. Note: Deadline for Student Stipend abstract submissions 15th July.
- 2. Ask your PhD supervisor to send an email to bcismrm@fmrib.ox.ac.uk, confirming your student status, and confirming your supervisor's membership of the BC-ISMRM.
- 3. By 31^{tst} July we will let you know whether your application for a Student Stipend has been successful and what contribution can be made towards your travel expenses.
- 4. Register for the conference in the normal way, but include a note that you have received a Student Stipend fee waiver. If you require conference accommodation, you must register by 5th August and pay the accommodation costs (£37.30 per night incl B&B).
- 5. When you attend the conference, successful applicants will be given a travel expenses claim form. This should be filled in, receipts (or validated copies) attached, and then returned to the conference address. We will refund agreed upon proportion of your travel expenses.
 Deadline for receipt of claims: 1st October.

Note: The Stipend Fund is finite. Depending on the popularity of Stipends, it may not be possible to pay the whole of your travel expenses. Also, it may not be possible to honour claims received after 1st October.
