Who can apply:

The International Society for Magnetic Resonance in Medicine, Section for MR Technologists (SMRT) invites MRI students, field related graduate students, and MR radiographers and technologists practicing less than 3 years and have a passion for the continuing education experience.

What are the guidelines:

- Describe a technique and its applications that you currently employ;
- Present innovative ways to improve professional practice;
- Undertake a literature review to research a topic/technique that is new or uncommon for the purpose of presenting your colleagues with an overview of current practice or standard of care; and/or
- Conduct your own research into a new technique or application.

Why apply:

- A monetary award of US \$600;
- A three-year membership in the SMRT;
- An appointment as a member of the SMRT Education Committee- Subcommittee for Professional Development; and
- Publication in the SMRT Annual Meeting materials and on the SMRT Website.

Where is the award presentation:

Award presentation will be held at the 23rd SMRT Annual Meeting in Milan, Italy, 10-11 May 2014. If the author is unable to attend the meeting, the author will be required to provide an electronic poster and personal bio for presentation during the meeting.
