The ISMRM Purpose:

- d) To work with or for, and to cooperate with local, regional and national governments and governmental and private agencies, organizations, firms and institutions in efforts to accomplish one or more of the above purposes.
- e) To ensure that scientists and clinicians working in the field have equal and fair opportunities to contribute to it.
