The successful applicant will join a team working on exciting projects focusing on low-field MRI development, working with a diverse group of physicists, imaging experts, and radiologists in our multi-disciplinary Center. The candidate will own a range of low-field MRI hardware projects including simulation, manufacture, and integration of B0 shim techniques, radiofrequency coils, and ancillary devices such as preamplifiers. The candidate will have the opportunity to pursue independent interests in accessible MRI and grow their own research team.

- Experience with hands-on hardware development
- Expertise in analog electronics
- Experience with circuit board design and manufacture
